SUBJECT: FY2020 Administration Funding Requests for the Bureau of Reclamation and the Army Corps of Engineers

The Trump Administration has now submitted its FY2020 agency funding proposals to the Congress. In terms of requested funding for the Army Corps of Engineers and the Bureau of Reclamation the news is grim as demonstrated by the figures detailed below. The WESTCAS Board of Directors will soon review draft letters to the Chairs and Ranking Members of the House and Senate Energy and Water Appropriations Committee that have jurisdiction over Corps of Engineers and Bureau of Reclamation funding expressing deep concern over the magnitude of these proposed reductions. WESTCAS will also be working with colleague associations in support of increased funding for these agencies.
