SUBJECT: Familiar Patterns

Much that has happened at the Federal level over the past 10 days may seem out of the ordinary. That includes the Senate impeachment trial and acquittal of President Trump, the Iowa caucus and the New Hampshire Presidential primary.

But there is also much that is a familiar part of the process such as last Tuesday's delivery of the State of the Union address and yesterday's release of the President's proposed FY2021 budget. The Congress will now put its own mark on the process by producing its own version of Federal discretionary spending which will be presented to the President to sign into law at some point after October 1.

Here are key requested spending levels from the President's proposed FY21 budget for the Army Corps of Engineers and the Bureau of Reclamation:
