STATUS OF THE SALTON SEA

Status Quo = declining ecology & economy

 North America's largest and most diverse migratory bird habitat outside the Everglades

- Salinity approaching 2 x ocean
- Algae blooms in Sea occasionally kill fish
- Water transfers in 2017: reduced inflow
- Less inflow: shoreline will shrink
- Exposure of nearly 100 sq miles of playa
- Air quality decline: odors and dust

- Funding expansion








TORRES MARTINEZ WETLAND PROJECT






RED HILL BAY PROJECT
